"A CONTRAST IN BEHAVIOR" Part-1 Re-cap

"AND be not drunk with wine, wherein is excess; but be filled with the Spirit" (Ephesians 5:19)

I. The Promise

- Being filled with the spirit is a fulfillment of the promise of the Lord
- You can be strong in the Lord because of the promise that fills your spirit
- There is no power in yourself but in the promise of the father; that is where your power comes from.
- Understand where your strength comes from: the spirit!

II. Be Filled with The Spirit

- Will you be filled with yourself or with the spirit?
- What does it mean to be filled with the Holy Spirit; it means to be under control of the spirit's presence
- There is a complete change that comes when you allow yourself to be transformed by the spirit.
- Understand that there is a contrast: to be filled with wine or to be filled with the spirit.

III. A Contrast in Behavior

- To understand your behavior sometimes it starts with knowing your beginning.
- The enemy is always trying to duplicate what God has already done.
- Remember the temple of Diana: you may have once been in the darkness, but you are now children of light



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- Remember to walk in love because of what God has done in your life
- Don't be unwise but remember the will of the Lord for your life
- When you fill yourself up with the spirit you can sing songs to the Lord (Send Judah 1st)
- Continually fill yourself with the spirit so you can be spirit controlled.
- Debauchery = sinfully filling yourself with those things that are contrary to that of the Lord.
- Salto = To pluck or play an instrument (Psalm & Hymn) when you make a song in your heart and allow yourself to become an instrument of praise.
- When you become an instrument of praise for God you begin to make a melody in your heart
- Will you be an Ode to God?
- Will you be able to lift up an adoration when the Holy Spirit moves?
- Your expression and praise should be spiritual and directly connected to God.
- When you encounter God, you should have a change in lifestyle (behavior change)
- Walk in love and peace because of the grace that was given to you by Christ
- Understand that the contrast in behavior is due to your encounter with God.
- Our lifestyle has to be ran by the Holy Spirit and the power of his might
- Because your filled with the Holy Spirit your filled with faith, hope and love
- If you are to be controlled by the spirit of God, you should have a marked contrast between what you use to be and what you can become.
- Don't go back to what you once were; be filled with the spirit and live in your new alternative lifestyle for God.
