## LESSON RECAP – SEPTEMBER 28, 2025

### Summary Paragraph:

You can have a house and still feel homeless in your soul. In Luke 15, Jesus tells a story that reveals how easy it is to be spiritually lost—even when everything looks fine on the outside. SisStar Katrina shared how this parable speaks deeply to our tendency to wander and the love of the Shepherd who comes after us.

### Key Teaching: The Nature of Sheep (and Us):

SisStar Katrina taught how God compares us to sheep—not by accident, but to show us something about our spiritual condition:

- **Sheep are defenseless:** They have no built-in way to protect themselves.
- **Sheep lack direction:** They get lost easily and can't find their way back.
- **Sheep are easily distracted:** Just a moment of curiosity can separate them from the flock.
- **Their cry invites danger:** When they call out, predators can hear them.

We're the same way—vulnerable, easily led astray, and unable to find our way back without help. That's why we need a Shepherd.

### Luke 15:3–7 – The Parable of the Lost Sheep:

Jesus says that if one sheep is lost, the shepherd leaves the 99 to search for it. When he finds it, he joyfully carries it home.

## LESSON RECAP – SEPTEMBER 28, 2025

### SisStar Katrina pointed out:

- The Shepherd doesn't wait—He **goes after** the one.
- He doesn't rebuke the sheep—He **lifts** it and **carries** it on His shoulders.
- The weight of the sheep reflects how Jesus **carried the weight of our sin** on the cross.
- Heaven **rejoices** over even **one** who is found.

---

### Why the Shepherd Notices One Is Missing:

To outsiders, sheep may look the same—but a good shepherd knows his flock. SisStar Katrina explained:

- A good shepherd walks **among** the sheep, smells like them, lives with them.
- He doesn't count heads—He **knows by heart** when one is missing.
- You are not invisible to God. He doesn't just see the crowd—He sees **you**.

---

### Spiritual Takeaway:

SisStar Katrina reminded us that many are “in the house” but still feel spiritually **homeless** present in church but far from God's voice.

She shared:

- Jesus doesn't just save us—He **seeks** us, **carries** us, and **celebrates** us.
- When He leaves the 99, He doesn't abandon them—He places them **somewhere safe**.
- You are **worth the pursuit**—He would come for you even if you were the only one.

## LESSON RECAP – SEPTEMBER 28, 2025

### The Voice of the Shepherd:

- The Shepherd **calls out**, and only His sheep recognize His voice.
- John 10:27 – “My sheep listen to my voice; I know them, and they follow Me.”
- SisStar Katrina emphasized: We follow Jesus not because we see Him, but because we **know His voice**.
- We don’t respond to guilt, fear, or manipulation, we respond to the **voice of peace, love, and truth**.

*This was only part one of the message. SisStar Katrina will continue unpacking what it means to be "housed but still homeless" in future sessions.*

*Until then, we rest in knowing that our **Good Shepherd sees us, seeks us, and carries us home.***
