 - *Micah 6:8: "He has shown you, O mortal, what is good. And what does the Lord require of you? To act justly and to love mercy and to walk humbly with your God."*
- **Romans 8:28:** Assurance that all things work together for good for those who love God.
 - *Romans 8:28: "And we know that in all things God works for the good of those who love him, who have been called according to his purpose."*
- **Purpose Defined:**
 - **Obedience as Purpose:** Living a life of faith and obedience aligns with God's purpose.
 - **Vertical Relationship:** Strengthening the relationship with God equips sisters to handle life's challenges.

2. Expected Outcome

- **Fulfillment of Purpose:**
 - **Eternal Rewards:** Various crowns are promised as rewards for obedience and faithfulness.
 - **Crown of Life:** James 1:12
 - *James 1:12: "Blessed is the one who perseveres under trial because, having stood the test, that person will receive the crown of life that the Lord has promised to those who love him."*
 - **Crown of Rejoicing:** 1 Thessalonians 2:19
 - *1 Thessalonians 2:19: "For what is our hope, our joy, or the crown in which we will glory in the presence of our Lord Jesus when he comes? Is it not you?"*

- **Crown of Righteousness:** 2 Timothy 4:8
 - *2 Timothy 4:8: "Now there is in store for me the crown of righteousness, which the Lord, the righteous Judge, will award to me on that day—and not only to me, but also to all who have longed for his appearing."*
- **Crown of Glory:** 1 Peter 5:4
 - *1 Peter 5:4: "And when the chief Shepherd appears, you will receive the crown of glory that will never fade away."*
- **Incorruptible Crown:** 1 Peter 1:4
 - *1 Peter 1:4: "And into an inheritance that can never perish, spoil or fade. This inheritance is kept in heaven for you."*
- **Worship and Glory to God:**
 - **Revelation 4:10-11:** Casting crowns before the throne, signifying ultimate worship.
 - *Revelation 4:10-11: "The twenty-four elders fall down before him who sits on the throne and worship him who lives for ever and ever. They lay their crowns before the throne and say: 'You are worthy, our Lord and God, to receive glory and honor and power, for you created all things, and by your will they were created and have their being.'"*
- **Eternal Perspective:**
 - **Hope Beyond Seasons:** Understanding that life in seasons is temporary, and eternity awaits with God.
 - *Psalm 139:14: "I praise you because I am fearfully and wonderfully made; your works are wonderful, I know that full well."*
 - *Genesis 2:7,15:*
 - *Genesis 2:7: "Then the Lord God formed a man from the dust of the ground and breathed into his nostrils the breath of life, and the man became a living being."*
 - *Genesis 2:15: "The Lord God took the man and put him in the Garden of Eden to work it and take care of it."*

APPLICATION AND TAKEAWAYS

- **Embrace Your Season:**
 - **Uniqueness:** Each sister's season is unique, much like snowflakes, emphasizing individuality in God's plan.
 - **Active Participation:** Sisters are encouraged to actively fulfill their purpose by "dressing" (laboring, working) and "keeping" (dwelling, protecting) as outlined in Genesis 2:15.
 - *Genesis 2:15: "The Lord God took the man and put him in the Garden of Eden to work it and take care of it."*
- **Strength Through Relationship:**
 - **Vertical Over Horizontal:** Prioritizing the relationship with God provides strength to handle life's horizontal challenges.
 - **Trust in God's Order:** Proverbs 3:5-6 underscores trusting in the Lord to direct one's path.
 - *Proverbs 3:5-6: "Trust in the Lord with all your heart and lean not on your own understanding; in all your ways submit to him, and he will make your paths straight."*
- **Purpose Beyond Self:**
 - **Avoid Comparison:** Sisters are reminded not to compare their purposes with others but to seek and follow God's unique plan for their lives.
 - **Lifelong Purpose:** Emphasizes that purpose continues regardless of age, highlighting that every moment is an opportunity to glorify God.
- **Eternal Significance:**
 - **Preparation for Eternity:** Understanding that fulfilling God's purpose has eternal implications, preparing sisters for their eternal home.
 - **Recycling Metaphor:** Just as water is recycled, God continuously uses sisters for His purposes, reinforcing their ongoing value and utility in His kingdom.
