“The God of a second(another) chance)

The following recap of Jonah Chapter 3 = 02-12-23 lesson.

Whatever you do keep the Lord with you! God will always be with you, but you must be open to his bidding!

I. Arise, Go Preach

- The important thing to remember about Jonah is not that he was in the belly of a fish but that he was instructed to preach the word.
- Jonah had to learn his lesson in the belly of a fish; sister follow God’s word the 1st time he gives it to you.
- It’s wrong for us to not obey Gods’ word when we first hear it.
- God is a God of Shayneet=(Hebrew word that means second time or second opportunity/chance)
- God is a Lord of second chance; praise him for second chances.
- In the spiritual realm- the number 2 means unity
- God gave Jonah a second chance to come into unity with him by doing his will.
- Get into step with God; he gives you second chances so that you can come into unity with him
- Each time God gives you the word it’s a second chance to come into unity/agreement with him and not your own.
- Remember the moral of “Horton hears a who” – be faithful to your spiritual egg that God has given you to birth
- God is faithful to what he says and what he says is faithful unto you.
- God’s word does not change to fit your circumstances; it’s designed so you can change to conquer your circumstance.
- God’s word will forever stand; God understands when your hurt and when you don’t do what he commands. But stand on his word anyway you can.

- The 2nd time Jonah was obedient to God’s word; he was delivered from his first pit and was given another chance.
- Be careful to not have an attitude like Jonah where you are looking down on your enemy.
- You are designed to bring peace to every circumstances.
- Don’t choose your pit of despair instead of overcoming!
- God doesn’t force obedience, but he allows you to repent!

II. Repentance and Forgiveness

- Who can tell if God will change his mind?
- The people of Nineveh heard God’s word , believed what he said, and acted in response to the word.
- Humble yourself and find what God has to say about your unforgiveness.
- You show your faith by what you do!
- God is concerned with the salvation of all men; when you repent you are turning away from sin
- When God turns away from sin it means that he is turning away from justice
- You are commissioned to pray for those Ninevites in your life!
- Your part is to be a witness to your enemies!
- Arise and go to the Ninevites in your life so that you can pray for them so that they may be saved.
- Forgiveness is apart of God’s plan; whether you believe it or not you can’t repay them.
- Vengeance belongs to the Lord; be kind just as Christ has forgiven you!
- If you want to look like your daddy you got to do what your daddy says!
- The word will not change and it’s apart of God’s plan! When you do his work, you give birth to his word so that others may be saved!
- God determines what will happen to others; we don’t know how others will respond to God’s word, so speak and live the word in all that you do!
