

LESSON RECAP – OCTOBER 26, 2025

Scripture Focus: John 6:29 (NIV) – "Jesus answered, 'The work of God is this: to believe in the one he has sent."

Summary Paragraph

Tiffany's message reminded us that our greatest work as believers isn't about *doing* — it's about *believing*. We often feel pressure to check spiritual boxes — prayer, service, study — but Jesus made it simple: **our main work is to believe in Him.**

In challenging times, when life feels heavy and faith feels thin, Jesus invites us not to perform more, but to *trust more*.

The heart of our relationship with God is our **belief system** — our anchor, our weapon, and our identity.

Main Points

1. Belief Is Our True Work

- o The crowd asked Jesus what they should *do* to do the works of God.
- His answer: Believe in the One He sent.

Our faith isn't measured by tasks completed, but by our trust in Christ.

2. Belief Is Our Identity

- o Belief isn't just something we *practice occasionally* it's who we *are* as daughters of the Most High.
- We're not striving for approval; we're standing in the grace we've already received (Ephesians 2:8–9).

Our belief keeps us anchored when the world shakes.

3. Belief Is Active — Not Passive

- o To "abide in Him" (John 15:4–5) means continually believing, trusting, and depending on Christ.
- When we believe, we activate the supernatural power within us the same power that raised Christ from the dead.

4. Belief Brings Confidence and Command

- Like soldiers following their commander, we trust our Commander-in-Chief, Jesus.
- We don't fight for victory we fight from victory, because it's already won through the cross.

Our confidence comes from obeying the One who leads us.

5. Belief Must Be Declared

- What we believe should come out of our mouths!
- o Romans 10:10 says belief happens in the heart, but confession comes from the mouth.
- o Proverbs 18:21: Life and death are in the power of the tongue.

Declare God's promises:

- "No weapon formed against me shall prosper" (Isaiah 54:17)
- "The joy of the Lord is my strength" (Nehemiah 8:10)
- "I am strong in the Lord and in His mighty power" (Ephesians 6:10)

Final Encouragement

- Your belief is your weapon, your anchor, and your identity.
- God isn't asking for perfection He's asking for faith.
- When the Commander speaks, our job is simple: **say it, do it, and go** believing that He already has the victory.
