### **Discussion Points/Questions:**

Using Jonah 1:8-9 and St. Matthew 26:69-75, talk about the differences between Jonah and Peter. Both were faced with sharing Truth, but each one took a different path. One was faithful - even in disobedience, and one was fearful.

- 1. What are some differences in how Jonah responded and how Peter reacted. What similarities do you see?
- 2. How is it possible for you to deny Christ, yet be a witness for Him?
- 3. Why do you think that Jonah was so comfortable in the midst of his disobedience?
- 4. Talk about things that you need to throw overboard as you awaken from your spiritual sleep.
- 5. Discuss how you can be spiritually asleep and not realize it.

#### SisStar Reflections

- 1. When you are disobedient to the Word of God, that is the same as running from God and the result will be the PIT.
- 2. Just as God sent Jonah on an errand of Mercy, so does He send you to others (your enemy, for example) to extend Mercy and not to get revenge.
- 3. As you let your light shine in the midst of your enemies, God will be glorified by your obedience.
- 4. If you expect to continue to receive God's Grace and Mercy, you must give as He has given to you.
