Word Definitions

- 1. **Faith**: An unwavering trust in God's promises and a firm belief in Him; confident trust; belief and trust in and loyalty to God.
- 2. **Trust**: Belief and faith in and loyalty to God. Confidence; resting of the mind on the integrity and veracity of God; an unwavering faith in Gods promises and confident faith in Him.
- 3. **In**: a preposition showing location; an enclosed place; shows specific location; being immersed in something; denoting a fixed place; a fixed position; an association or union with someone; an intimate relationship with the object.
- 4. **The**: a function word pointing to a definite object, a unique article. "The" means that something specific will follow.
- 5. **Lord**: specific and unique; "the" precedes a noun that is specific; "THE LORD" ...specific and unique. Not "A" lord...but THE LORD.

- 6. **With**: a preposition meaning "together" or "along with" or "in conjunction with; a function word to indicate a participant in an action.
- 7. **All**: Not a part but with ALL...total; your whole self;
- 8. **Thine**: Your
- 9. **Heart**: Your mind will and emotions. The inner self your thoughtlife your thinking process; the place of belief and faith.
- 10. **And**: A function word which will show a contrast between the first clause of the verse and the second clause.
- 11. **Lean**: To rely on or trust for assistance;
- 12. **Not**: In no wise; under no circumstances;
- 13. Unto: "To" or "towards"...or to become one with.
- 14. Thine: Your
- 15. **Own**: Personal; belonging to you; yours;
- 16. **Understanding**: Your own way of doing things; your personal thinking.

As can be seen from the number of scriptures where the words are used, "trust" is more of an Old Testament usage and the word "faith" is more of New Testament usage. Both words are interchangeable and have basically the same meaning.

Faith: An unwavering trust in God's promises and a firm belief in Him; confident trust. Belief and trust in and loyalty to God.

Trust: Belief and faith in and loyalty to God. Confidence; resting of the mind on the integrity and veracity of God; trust in the promises of God.
