- **❖** Threshing floor = (Place of preparation and revelation)
- ❖ The word vomited= (Gods' way of allowing you to get rid of those evil things in your stomach)

\*\*God is amazing in the way he allows your body to produce saliva; which then protects your teeth and tongue from the acid- God gives protection for your tongue and mouth\*\*

- ❖ Jonah had to be admitted to the fishes' stomach for 3days the same happened with our savior Jesus.
- ❖ Jesus had to be spewed out of hell because his power made it sick.
- ❖ The great fish couldn't hold Jonah once God told it to spew out Jonah.
