Tiffany's Lesson Re-Cap | 05-19-24 | "Short but Sweet"

The following is a recap of the "Short but Sweet" lesson

2Cor 5:7 = For we walk by faith, not by sight (Living our lives in a manner consistent with our confident belief in God's promises)

There is a scene from the movie "Forward" the main scene is one where a young man is on a quest to find his precious jewel that is going to give him the opportunity to meet his father (who had passed away) for 24hrs.

During this scene the young man along with his older brother come across this faith bridge...the younger brother is afraid of taking a leap on this faith bridge. The older brother says "I have a rope that I will tie around you incase you start to loose faith" The only thing for you to do is keep looking forward, don't look back stay focused. Unbeknownst to the younger brother the rope that was his safety was actually to short and was not holding him while he was stepping out on faith.

Sistar there are 3 things you need to do in order to walk on your faith bridge of life.

I. Step Out- Heb 11:1

- Sistar you must walk out your faith.
- It's 1 thing to talk about the things that God can do; but it's another thing to actually put it into action.
- Sistar step out on faith and trust in God with all your heart.

II. Believe that it's already done – Mark 9:23

- Sistar you must believe in the God you serve!
- If God can make a sea part and God's people walk on dry land.. you must believe!
- If you can believe that God can take 3 hebrew boys and have them thrown into a fiery furnest and they survive and not smell like smoke....you must believe!
- If you can believe that God can take bones that were dead and bring them back to life again... you must believe!
