I. Over-view -Unprepared Preparation

- ♥ God will supply your needs; not the wants but everything you need in life.
- ♥ A lesson from Chickens with attitude

There were a bunch of hens who had been on the chicken farm. They spent their days cackling and talking to each other. The farmer always came through and fed them what they needed to produce eggs like they were meant too. One day the head Hen of the group started grumbling and complaining about why they always had to eat corn. 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- ♥ Preparation is the key to navigating the uncharted territories of life
- ♥ The lessons to come are going to discuss the type of woman = Godly woman that will be charting unknown territory
- ♥ When you face the uncertainties of life will you set sail or become shipwrecked
- ♥ Remembering who you are directly influences who you are and how you take on the challenges of life.
- ♥ A Godly woman takes on challenges remembering who she is, to whom she belongs too.
- ♥ Remembering who you are helps you sail through the uncharted territories of life.
- ♥ Godly living is about understanding that you are not directing your ship; you recognize that you are not in control but it's the God who lives in and through you.

II. Ruth

- ♥ Ruth was willing to step into uncharted territory by trusting in a God she did not know.
- ♥ Moab= unbelief; the washpot, the garbage can
- ♥ Ruth and Naomi had to leave Moab because of famine = It is better to be in Christ and experience a famine than to be without God living in abundance
- ♥ Ruth and Naomi left during Barley Harvest- (Barley harvest means the place of new beginnings) in life you will have to be willing to leave toward your Barley harvest
- ♥ When you have faith in the right object (God) you can conquer the unknown territories of life.
- ♥ Ruth was from a land of unbelievers but was willing to go to uncharted territories and because of her obedience she is listed in the lineage of Christ
- ♥ Sistar you must be a Godly woman willing to charter life's territories
- ♥ You are here for such a time as this; you are not too early nor are you too late
- ♥ Live in Proverbs 3:5-7; trust in the Lord and let the Lord sail your ship



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III. **Esther** (*encourage you to read the book of Esther*)

Because God loves you; your sins are forgiven! You have been saved by grace, not by yourself but your faith in the one who is all and is all

- ♥ When you face unprepared situations, you can navigate because of your faith in the Lord
- ♥ When you look back at the unexpected events in your life you can see the hands of God leading you each step of the way.
- ♥ The book of Esther is interesting because the name of God was never mentioned- yet God’s people were saved
- ♥ Esther was made queen because of the providence of God allowing her to have grace.
- ♥ Esther was not groomed to become a queen, yet she trusted in Mordecai’s instruction and followed the instruction
- ♥ God will use any method & any one to get his message through.
- ♥ God’s will always prevail; he is preserving you for his purpose and glory
- ♥ God is the “Great I am!” he was here before time, and will continue to be through the end of time
- ♥ The enemy will always try to put out the light of God. But when order, peace, and acceptance stand firm the enemy can’t win
- ♥ Esther took a risk into uncharted territory when she went to beseech the King.
 - **Golden Scepter**-sign of design favor; authority- when the King held it out one could approach him.
 - When faith & Love combine there is nothing that can prevail
 - **Judah** = Praise
 - **Shiloh** = The Messiah (Jesus Christ)
 - Your Power is in the praise; send Judah first! Shiloh is coming back again with a scepter of honor! Will you be ready? Shiloh will come to judge with all power! Every knee shall have to bow!*
 - Wow- It’s in your praise! You have been extended the golden scepter!*
 - God knows what he’s doing! He’s knows what he’s doing and he’s coming back for you!*
- ♥ Whether in Winter, Spring, Summer, or Harvest you are created for a reason and you have a purpose and light that must shine



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- ♥ You are created to give God praise and pleasure; no matter what issues come your way you can charter through the territory
- ♥ When you know God is on your side! All you can say is Wow!
