

The following is a lesson recap of SisStar Tiffany's "Father Can you hear me?...But daughter are you listening?"

SisStars God always has an answer for any situation we may be going through but are you listening to what God is saying?

There will always be people who will try to have you believe that God will turn things around if you do a certain task or set up.

God wants you to hear from him by creating relationship with him.

God welcomes your questions, but he wants you to give him your "yes."

I. Consider your motives to wanting to hear from God.

- SisStar be honest about why you are seeking God in the first place.
- Are you making God a last resort instead of going to God first?
- SisStar sometimes you create situations; you are putting yourself in.
- When you are not honest with God you block the space that Holy Spirit is trying to occupy.
- SisStar confess your faults; get into alignment with what God says in his word.



II. Your Goal should be more than just hearing from God.

- SisStar when we ask God: "Father can you hear me" it's because we want God to answer in the way we want.
- Hearing from God is about becoming more spiritually open and spiritually mature in what God has planned out for you.
- SisStar make sure you remember the gospel of peace(which is Christ Jesus)
- When you remember who you are in Christ you will always be ready to hear from the Lord.
- Hearing from God is not to only get an answer but to build your relationship in God.
- God wants you to glean from him; but he needs for you to prepare your mind for what God is trying to give you.

III. Don't try to force God to tell you something!

- SisStar are you wanting God to tell you what you want to hear? Or are you okay when he gives you his honest answer.
- When God speaks; sometimes we try to bargain with the Lord because we want to do the things we want to do.
- While we wait for God to answer...it's our time to work at building our trust!
- Check your mindset SisStar; when God doesn't answer in the way you want...will you still stand on his promises?



- SisStar if God brings you to a circumstance; then he has already given you what you need to grow through the trial.
- Are you developing relationship based on what God gives and not what you desire?
- Will you stand with God when you are facing the trials of life?
- Will you utter "My God has brought me out before and he will do it again because he is faithful.

IV. Recognize that God communicates in many forms, but most often through your mind!

- Sometimes SisStars God will use dramatic ways to speak to you: visions or big events.
- Sometimes God will use ordinary practices to speak to you:
- Your word, your prayer, your personal study time.
- SisStar you must work out your own soul salvation by using the tools that God has given you to fight the enemy!
- When you use the tools God has for you; you will begin to shift your mindset.
- SisStar there are others in this world that are dying because they proclaim the name of Jesus and being Christians...you SisStar live in a country that allows you to freely read the Bible...freely to pray and you won't even make the attempt.



- SisStar begin to block the noise of the world and listen to the small still voice that is trying to hear you.
- SisStar it's time for you and I to have a new heart (mindset)
- God is waiting for you to invite Holy Spirit to come in so he can begin the transformations you need.
- SisStar you don't need any crystals, or rocks, or jewel beads...you just need to be open!
- When you ask "Father can you hear me?..he is saying daughter are you listening?
- Use your tools and allow God to transform you from the inside out!
