"What is the cause?"

Matthew 5:22

"But I say unto you, that whosoever is angry with his brother (her sister) WITHOUT A CAUSE shall be in danger of the judgement."

Sistars 2024 is the year of new beginnings and release. The world will know you are controlled by the spirit of love and not anger! Anger is a real emotion but don't allow it to control you and your actions! Don't allow anger to put you in a downward spiral that leads you to the P.I.T. (Personally Induced Turmoil)

I. Justifiable Anger (What is the cause?)

- A *cause* is a reason, an excuse, a way to seek to remove blame from yourself.
- There is always a cause for your anger, but you need to make sure it's justified.
- Don't allow your past to dictate your current circumstance.
- Sistar you have to make a choice to forget(not control your actions)
- Why do you shift blame for the things you do onto God or others?
- Sistar sometimes you will have cause to be angry but you can't allow that to consume you.



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- Be sure to know the difference between the excuse and a real cause to be angry.
- Sistar when you get angry who are you blaming?
- Are you allowing your blame to prevent you from being able to worship God in spite of your trial?
- Be careful where you put your "little ole statements."
- Sistar God says live peacefully with all; don't hold on to your anger.
- Sistar you might be the one God is using to show others the love he has for others.
- God places the responsibility for reconciliation on you Sistar!
- Justifiable cause- (To be angry because you don't like someone. To be angry when you are the offender)
- The result from unresolved anger is unresolved issues.

II. Don't Hold On

- Even when your angry don't allow the sun to go down on your wrath.
- When you allow your anger to continue you are not putting off the things God says will corrupt you.
- Holding on to anger will cause you to fester and form a pus(an infection and poison that can take over the body)
- Anger unresolved will become a poison that will lead to a spiritual infection that leads you to unresolve.
- Anger is a horizontal issue; when you stay focused vertically you are able to overcome the horizontal issues.
- When you see that the things in your mind don't agree with what God says then you will fall short in your connecting with God.



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- If you hold on to anger you allow the sun to go down on your wrath; if you die with the sun going down you don't have a chance to fix it.
- Sistar anger is not easy to overcome; you must learn the art of backing away.
- Every situation does not deserve a response; studying being silent is a lesson that God commands.
- Be transformed by the renewing of your mind Sistar!
- Sometimes we like the feeling of being mad; sometimes being mad feels good...but ultimately it leads to no earthly good.
- Sistar ask yourself is holding on to your anger worth the risk of losing your eternal reward?
- When you hold on to anger you give power to the one who is offending you; allow God to be in control.
- Use the 9 parts of the fruit of the spirit to sustain you.
- You might get bothered but don't think your pleasing God by holding on to things that don't control you.
- If you act in accordance with God's word you won't give place to the devil.
- Submit yourself to God sistar!
 - Submit- Put yourself under God's authority!
 - **Resist-** Stand against the enemy!
 - **Flee** *Step away from your emotions and step into the mind of God!*
