II. Kinds of Prayer

1) Supplication: *To ask humbly and earnestly; an entreaty; to kneel; to seek or ask for by humble entreaty; to submissively pray.*

- Daniel 9:3-4 Ephesians 6:18 Philippians 4:6 I Timothy 2:1 Hebrews 5:7

2) Prayer (proseuche): *Prayer in general; to request; to ask.*

- I Thess. 5:17 Colossians 4:2

3) Prayer (deesis/supplication): *A much stronger word, which stresses a need; a sense of urgency; shows agony.*

- II Kings 20:2-3 St. Matthew 26:36-38 St. Luke 22:41-45

4) Intercession: *A petition on behalf of others; meeting with God to offer a plea for another.*

- Numbers 14:13-20 Acts 12:5 Acts 12:12 Romans 8:26-27 Romans 10:1

5) **Gratitude:** *Giving of thanks; thankfulness; this is a prayer of thanksgiving, and not to request or ask for anything from God. Strictly – “God, I THANK You.”*

○ St. Luke 2:38 Philippians 4:6 II Cor. 9:11-12 Ephesians 5:4

- ❖ When we go through trials, we can count it all joy; it may not be joyous when you’re going through the trial but you will always have joy!
- ❖ As a believer when trials come you have extra strength to go through it because God is on your side.
- ❖ Every day you wake up you can stand by Proverbs 3:5-6 trusting that he can handle all your problems.
- ❖ Whatever lies ahead of you is not something you have to worry about because God is already ahead of you and knows what the end result will be.
- ❖ You might have moments where you feel overwhelmed but remember your struggles are already won.
- ❖ Victory is won in your own Garden of Gethsemane(place of daily surrender)
- ❖ Sometimes you have to be pressed in order for your oil to run.
- ❖ On a daily basis you should strive to be transformed so that the mind of Christ will be with you!
- ❖ Prayer is a daily tool you should be accessing in order to grow closer with God!

God has already gone to prepare the way; he only desires for us to trust him daily.
