Discussion Questions

- 1. Have you ever found yourself in a place where you felt like you were drowning? Discuss.
- 2. What was the answer that worked for you in order to get out of that place of despair?
- 3. Did you find that the place of despair was an opportunity for spiritual growth?
- 4. How do you forsake your own mercy, and how do you reclaim what God has for you?
- 5. Discuss vows and the danger of making a vow and not keeping that commitment.
- 6. When does your praise become a "sacrifice?"
- 7. How does the sacrifice of praise help you to get out of the PIT?

SisStar Reflections

- 1. When you "feel" like God has left you, know that the Lord has promised never to leave you nor forsake you.
- 2. God has never made a promise that He will not keep. All the promises of God are "yea and amen."
- 3. When you step over your feelings and step into the Truth of the Word of God, you are giving God what belongs to Him. This is your Vertical Relationship.
- 4. The secret to overcoming your feelings is found in James 4:7: "Submit yourself therefore to God, Resist the devil, and he will Flee from you."

- 5. You can live a life of purpose every day by obedience to the Word. "Purpose" means to follow the dictates of our Lord in every area of your life. (Proverbs 3:5-6)
- 6. Life's issues will continue to happen daily; but in spite of those daily happenings, you can have that inner Joy and Peace that comes from your Vertical Relationship with God.
- 7. The only thing that you can be sure of is the Word of God, which will never change.
- 8. The Word of God is sharp and powerful enough to cut, but tender enough to heal.
- 9. As you "Send Judah (Praise) First" you will find your Jerusalem (place of peace).
